



TOURING TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS AT A GLANCE

The following outlines Dance Kaleidoscope's minimum technical requirements. If any items listed are unavailable in your inventory, the Presenter and the Company can discuss suitable alternatives.

Stage/Floor Requirements for Large-Venue Engagements

- Minimum stage size/dancing area: 40' wide X 30' deep.
- Minimum offstage area: 6' in width from the offstage stage edge of legs.
- Crossover behind the stage, minimum 6' wide, must be indoors without steps, with blue running lights where needed.
- A sprung wooden dance sub-floor covering the dancing area, with a black vinyl marley-type dance floor to cover the entire performing space.

Stage/Floor Requirements for Small-to-Mid Venue Engagements

- Minimum stage size/dancing area: 28' wide x 15' deep.
- A sprung wooden dance sub-floor covering the dancing area, with a black vinyl marley-type dance floor to cover the entire performing space.

Lights: A general light plot should include front, side, and top lighting. Full recommended lighting requirements are available in the technical rider.

Sound: Stereo amplification and loudspeakers sufficient for the house, and a mixing console 2 to 4 stage monitors, 1 microphone, and headsets on a one-channel system. The Company will provide playback.

Crew: Requirements vary upon repertoire and venue. Crew personnel must be the same for all rehearsals and performances.

Dressing Rooms: 2 separate dressing rooms with space for 7 men and 7 women, and costume racks.

Rehearsal Space: The stage where the performance is to be held must be available to the Company two hours before each performance and must have ballet barres to accommodate dancers.

Hospitality: The Company respectfully requests that the Presenter provide water, refreshments, and a hot meal after the performance.

Transportation and Lodging: Transportation and lodging can either be covered by the Presenter or built into the booking fee.

Technical requirements will become the Technical Addendum to Dance Kaleidoscope's Performance Agreement and, upon approval, will be signed by the Presenter and the Presenter's Technical Director.
